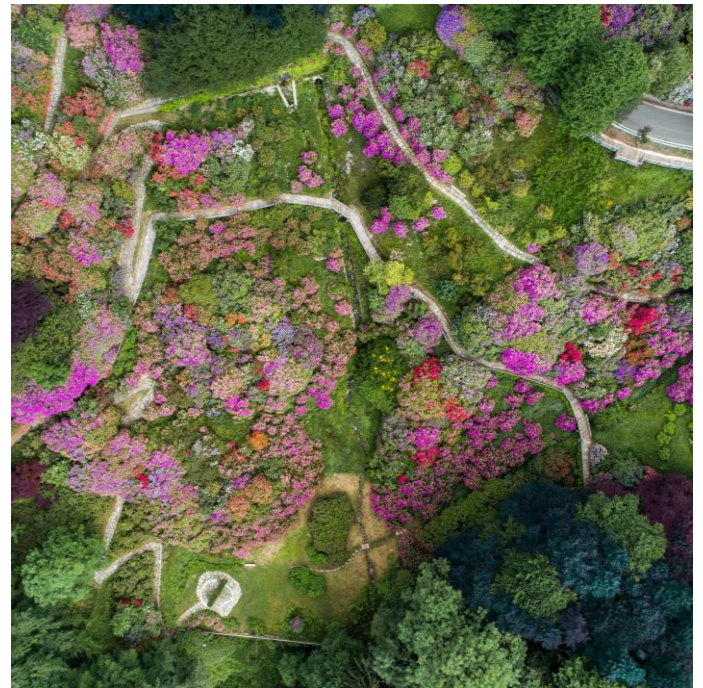

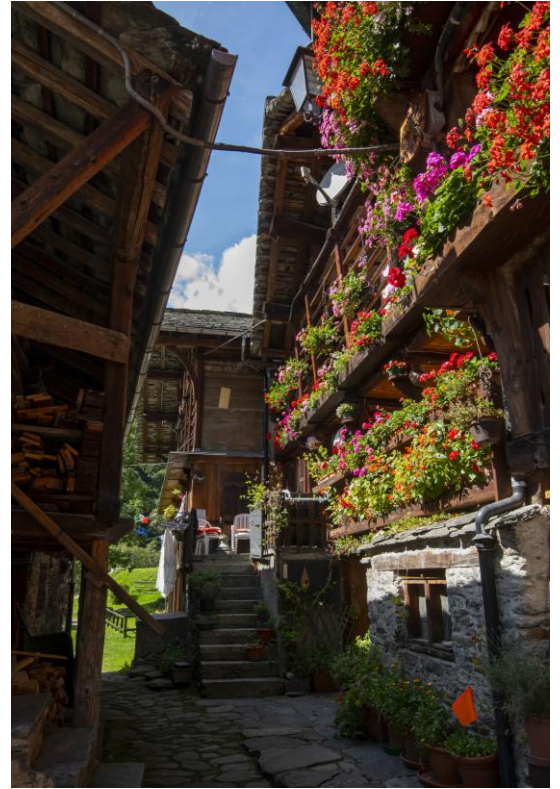

THE HEART OF MONFERRATO AMONG INFERNOT AND GENTLE HILLS

A route through the gentle hills where, millions of years ago, there was the sea. The land of Aleramo and Marchesato, among castles and unique villages, a land of wines as proud as its people, where you can find the undisputed king of food and wine, His Majesty the truffle.

PROGRAM

DAY 1: Arrival in **Casale Monferrato** and guided tour of the town, from the **synagogue** built in 1595 to the streets of the town centre, among the shops dominated by the 11th century Civic Tower. A visit to the Civic Museum with its **picture gallery** and **gallery of plaster casts** is recommended. Dinner in a historical inn to taste traditional Monferrato dishes. Accommodation in an excellent winery and overnight stay.

DAY 2: Typical breakfast and free transfer to **Vignale Monferrato** for the **truffle hunt**. Free transfer to Rosignano for tasting in a **wine cellar**. In the afternoon, a walk to **Cella Monte**, one of the most beautiful villages in Italy, where the streets are lined with shells trapped in the walls and underground chambers dug by hand under the houses, called **infernot**.

DAY 3: After breakfast, free transfer to **Altavilla Monferrato**, where we suggest a guided visit to an **historic distillery** where you can take part in a sensory tasting of typical grappas and distillates.

SUSTAINABILITY

A land worth travelling to for the stories it has to tell. The sustainability of this itinerary is enriched by the inclusive values that come from a great tradition, but also by natural values that illuminate places where immersion in the most pronounced biodiversity is also a great cultural opportunity.

DISCOVERING THE LOWER PIEDMONT, GAVI, ALESSANDRIA AND TORTONA

From the homeland of Cortese wine to the multifaceted city of Umberto Eco and the world's most famous made-in-Italy hat, the Borsalino, to Tortona, the Roman Derthona, to immerse yourself in the hills where art, wine and culture blend in perfect harmony.

PROGRAM

DAY 1: Arrival in the medieval village of Gavi for a guided tour of the town followed by a free transfer for a guided tour of the fortress. Dinner and overnight at a winery in the Gavi area.

DAY 2: After a typical breakfast, transfer to Alessandria to visit the Borsalino Museum with the felt hat, created in Alessandria 166 years ago, to discover its history through modern multimedia. A stop at one of the Pasticcerie Botteghe Storiche to taste the De. Co. brand specialities. Dinner in an Osteria with a menu of traditional dishes such as the typical *rabaton*. Accommodation in a central hotel.

DAY 3: Breakfast at the hotel and departure for Tortona, a town rich in history, where it is said that the Templars hid the Holy Grail in the 13th century. We recommend a visit to the Museum of Divisionism and to the homes of Pellizza da Volpedo, author of the famous painting "Il Quarto Stato" (The Fourth State), as well as a visit to and tasting in a typical historic wine cellar.

SUSTAINABILITY

We are in a land that at this moment is more than ever characterised by the pride of telling its own story. This, in Piedmont in particular, is already a value of sustainability. Starting from Gavi, its medieval village and historical tradition linked to the Pilgrim's Way to Santiago, continuing on to Alessandria and Tortona, sustainability acquires an even more important role for the valorisation of the existing made of unique landscapes in which to immerse oneself with all the senses, from smell to touch.

THREE DAYS IN LOWER VALLE MAIRA BETWEEN WALKS AND NATURALISTIC AND CULTURAL DISCOVERIES

The Lower Valle Maira, rich in orchards, vineyards and cultivated fields, will welcome you in its hamlets full of history and culture, with pleasant walks, historical, religious and natural insights and local producers. A beauty of landscapes, history and culture to be visited and... enjoyed.

PROGRAM

DAY 1: Arrival and accommodation. In the afternoon, we suggest some outdoor activities in the area. A **pleasant walk in the Contado** of the Benedictine Abbey of San Pietro in Vincoli in Villar San Costanzo. Dinner with a tasting menu based on local and traditional products of the area and **typical Occitan cuisine**. Return and overnight stay at the residence.

DAY 2: Typical breakfast. In the morning, guided visit to the old mill of the Dronero riviera. In the afternoon, guided visit to the **nature reserve of Ciciu di Villar**. Return to the hotel and overnight stay.

DAY 3: Typical breakfast. In the morning, a visit to the **Occitan Museum 'Sòn de Lengà' - Espaci Occitan'** dedicated to Occitan culture is recommended.

SUSTAINABILITY

Occitan culture has a particularly high sustainability figure in terms of history, development and traditions. The Valle Maira not only tells this story, but also guarantees an immersion in a variety of proposals included in a single itinerary, from the splendour of the Ciciu, to the products of the Riviera Mill, to a menu that combines seasonality and craftsmanship in dishes such as ravioles and doba, to immersing oneself in the intense perfume of anchovies along one of the salt routes.

CUNEO AND SAVIGLIANO: ART, CULTURE AND GOOD FOOD

Discover the lively historic arcades that criss-cross the city of Cuneo, stopping in the small shops, specialty shops, historic cafés... and then admire the beauty of Savigliano, living a sensory experience where "perfume" is the protagonist... Finally, spend some time in contact with nature.

PROGRAM

DAY 1: Arrival in **Cuneo** and check-in at the hotel. In the afternoon, meeting with the guide and visit of the historical centre of the city, with a **gourmet break in a pastry shop** to taste a delicious meringue with cream and IGP hazelnuts. In a **typical brewery**, meat-based dinner with excellent products of the Granda area. Return to the hotel and overnight stay.

DAY 2: Typical breakfast. Free transfer to **Savigliano**. Meeting with the guide to discover the medieval town with its noble palaces. Tasting of a typical **white vermouth** and visit to the **sensory workshop** of the Muses - Accademia Italiana delle Essenze. Return to Cuneo and overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 3: Breakfast at the hotel. A pleasant walk along **Viale degli Angeli**, among liberty-style buildings, to Parco della Resistenza and the Sanctuary of the Madonna degli Angeli, with its outstanding Juarrian altar is recommended. Stop at the **Casa del Fiume**, an environmental education centre with an educational apiary.

SUSTAINABILITY

The cities of the Granda, as the people of Cuneo call their province, are committed to sustainability in their quality of life. And this is exactly what the itinerary tells us. The closeness between the city and nature is enhanced and becomes a way of life. From walks along the river to tastings that combine tradition and the values of the land.

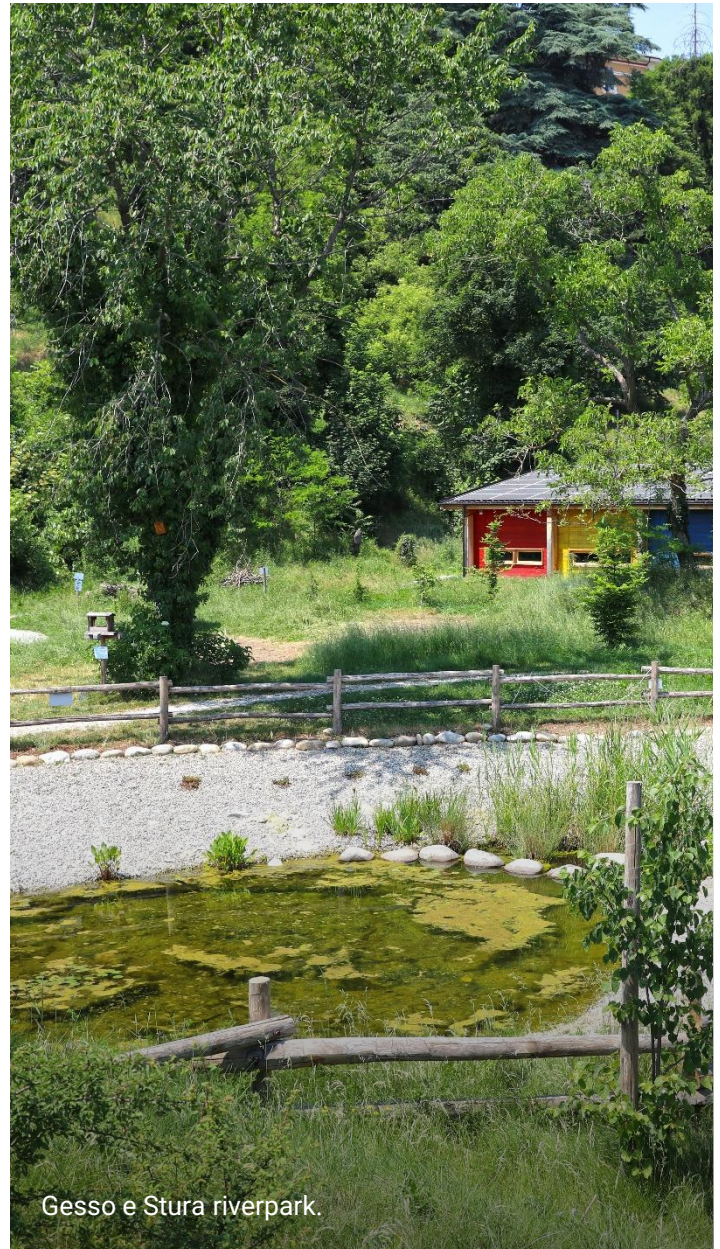

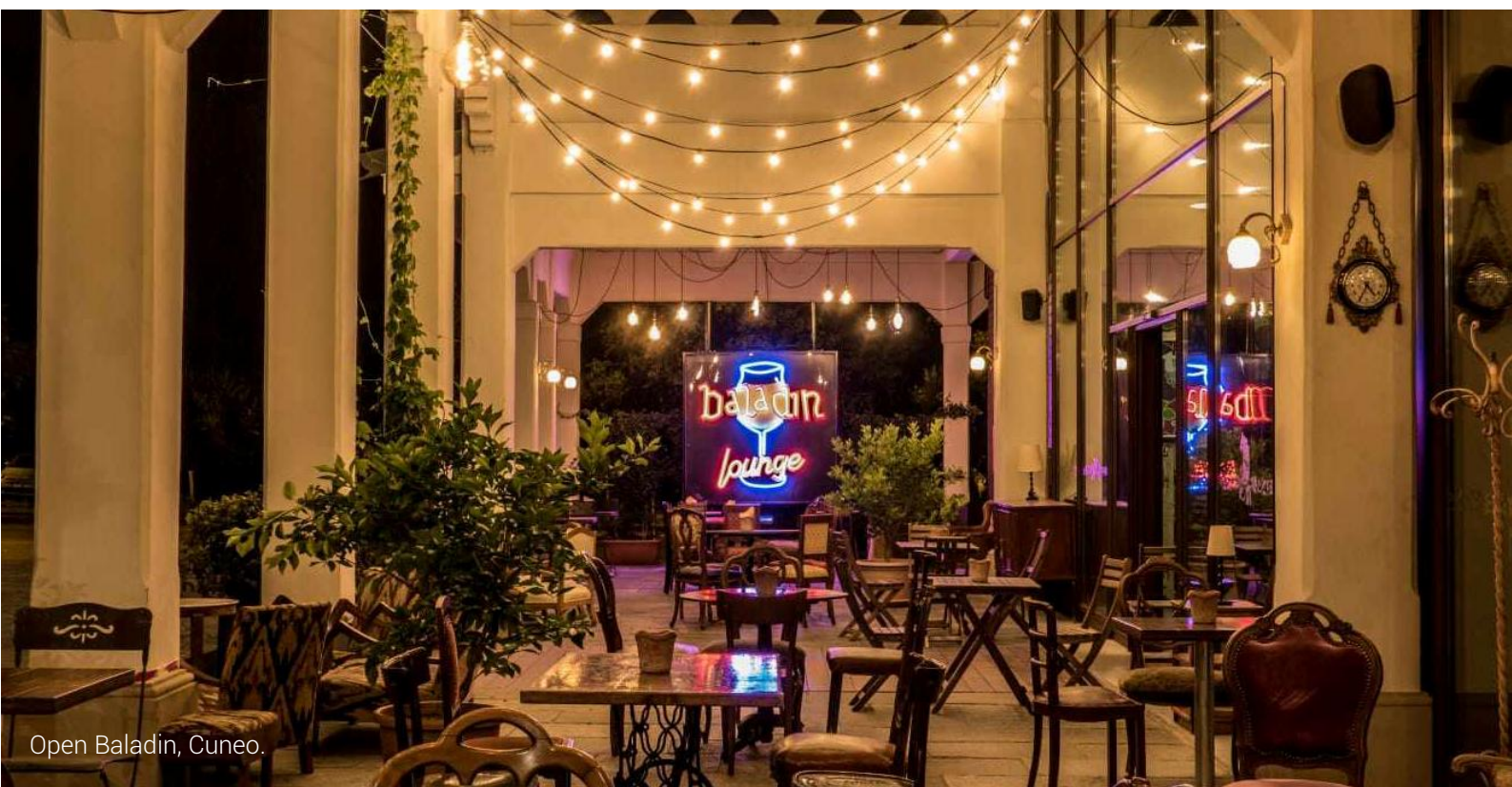

FROM LAKE ORTA TO OSSOLA MOUNTAINS

From the natural jewel of Lake Orta, nestled in the hills, through castles and vineyards up the Ossola Valley to the Monte Rosa massif.

PROGRAM

DAY 1: Morning arrival on the shores of Lake Orta. A visit to the characteristic village of **Orta San Giulio** is recommended. In the afternoon free transfer to **Vogogna**. Visit to the nearby medieval castle, originally a defensive fortress and customs post, and a visit to the **wine cellar** with tasting of local wines. Overnight stay in Domodossola.

DAY 2: Breakfast and guided tour of the historic centre of **Domodossola**, a true architectural jewel of the Western Alps. In the afternoon, free transfer to **Santa Maria Maggiore** for a visit to the historic centre and the old town hall. Dinner in a typical **mountain trattoria**. Return to the hotel and overnight stay.

DAY 3: After breakfast, departure for the **Valle Anzasca** to admire the eastern face of the **Monte Rosa**. Stop to visit a **producer of sausages** made from the black pigs native to Monte Rosa, which guarantee the unique quality of the finished product. We will continue on our own to **Macugnaga**, where we will have a "*merenda sinoira*" with typical local products. Guided visit to the **Guia gold mine**.

SUSTAINABILITY

Lake Orta, Orta San Giulio, Valle Vigezzo, Valle Anzasca. A real dance among the natural heritage that surrounds Lake Orta like a crown of jewels. Not only to be seen, to be heard, to be smelled among the unique perfumes of the territory, but also to be tasted among the Bettelmat and other excellences. Something unique, like the territory. Sustainable by nature.

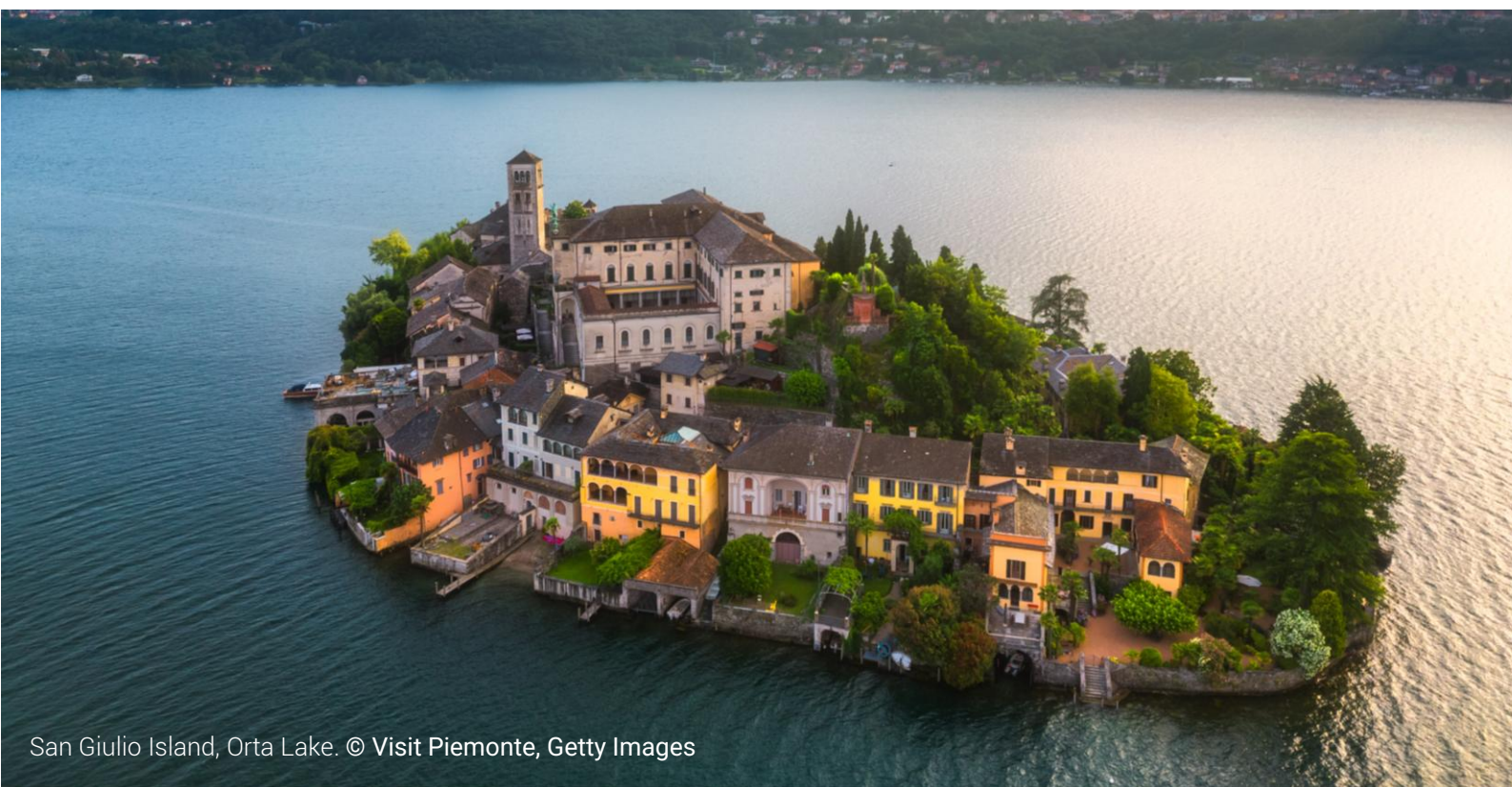

TASTE AND NATURE: A WEEKEND OF GOOD FOOD AND SUSTAINABLE MOBILITY

An active, green holiday that combines outdoor experiences with excellent food. Fresh air, villages and castles, hazelnuts, wine, typical restaurants and picnics.

PROGRAM

DAY 1: Arrival and check-in at accommodation. Dinner in a selected restaurant where you can taste the **typical local cuisine**. Overnight stay.

DAY 2: Wake up to a tasty breakfast, carefully prepared with typical and genuine products. Transfer to the **Alta Langa** by private car and meeting with an **expert cycling guide**: briefing and departure for a personalised route on a pedal-assisted handbike. Along the way, lunch with a **rich picnic of traditional delicacies**. Return to the hotel and overnight stay.

DAY 3: After breakfast, transfer to **Barolo** by private vehicle and visit with audio-guide to the **Wine Museum - WiMu**, an interactive journey through the history of wine production, an immersion in the evocative thousand-year relationship between man and wine.

SUSTAINABILITY

Routes, places and flavours. The gastro-natural itinerary proposed in the hills of Barolo and Alta Langa demonstrates how the valorisation of the local gastronomic heritage can be an engine of sustainability, balanced between zero kilometres and the preservation of the natural heritage, offering everyone the chance to experience a total immersion in the flavours of the hills.

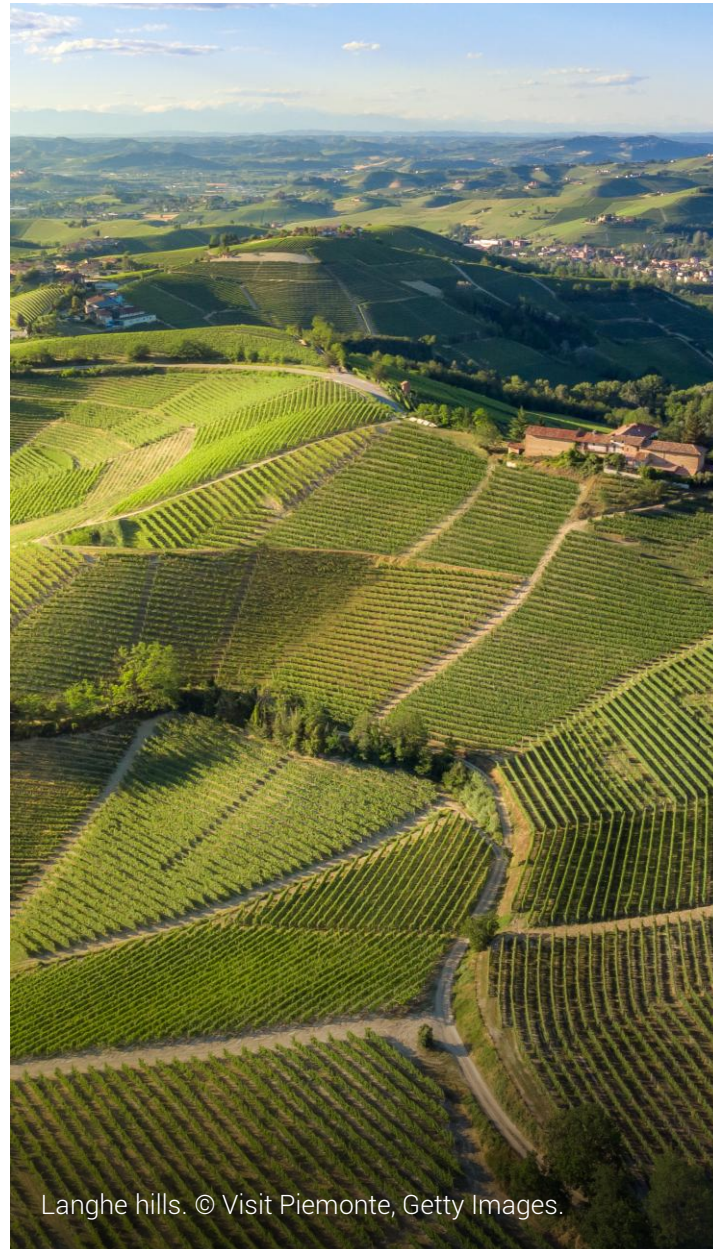

Take part in experiential activities that enhance local produce, respect biodiversity and sustainability, and discover the food and wine excellence of a generous land through the stories of its people.

PROGRAM

DAY 1: Independent arrival at the accommodation. Visit to a **company that processes IGP Piedmontese hazelnuts from the Langhe** and tasting. Dinner at a selected restaurant where you can taste typical local dishes. Overnight stay.

DAY 2: Wake up to a sumptuous breakfast prepared with care using typical and genuine products. Transfer to **Cherasco** by private vehicle and departure for a **guided olfactory walk** along a route that winds under the porticoes and through the streets of the centre of Cherasco. **Olfactory-tasting sensory game "Cherasco - Perfume & Chocolate"** in the showroom of the refined Salotto di Fragranze. Return to the hotel and overnight stay.

DAY 3: After breakfast, you will be taken to a forest in the Langa to experience the emotion of a **simulated truffle hunt**, a UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage. A sensory experience of great value.

SUSTAINABILITY

What could be more sustainable than valorising a heritage that has always been produced in an area and doing it through a sensory immersion? The enveloping scent of hazelnuts, the taste of chocolate... a thrilling experience enriched by the adventure of truffle hunting. Nature becomes a lasting spectacle.

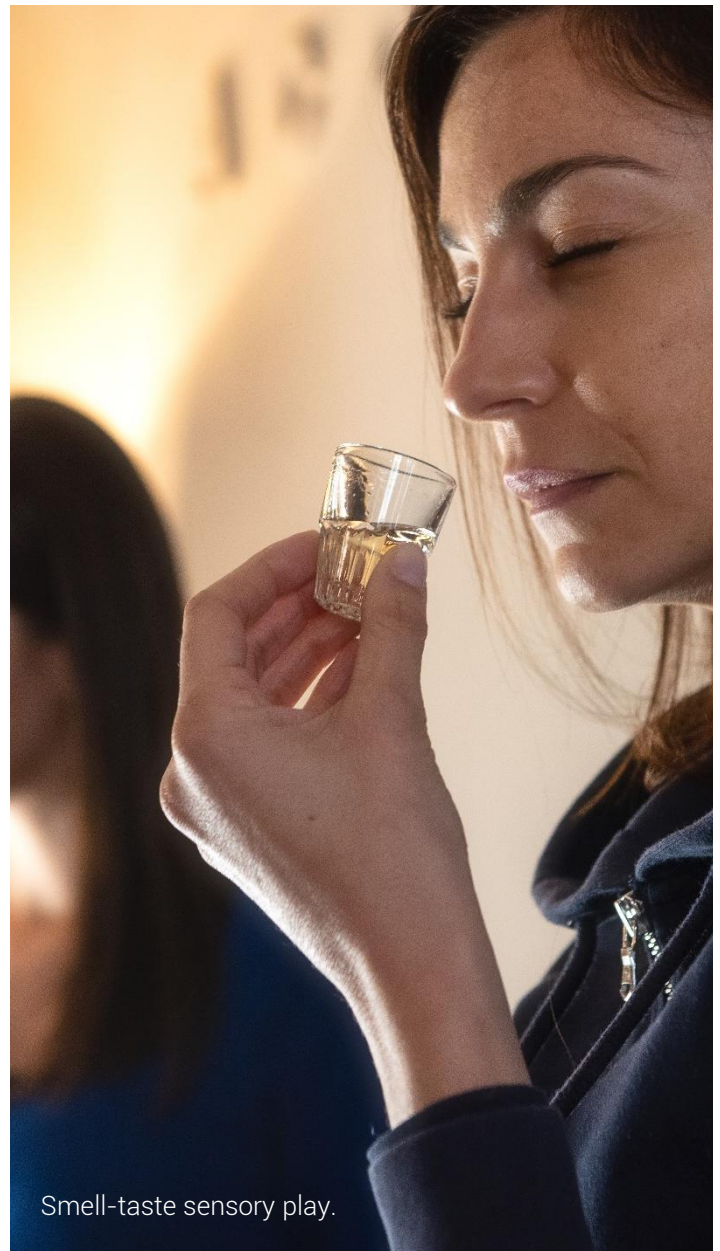

HISTORY, SPIRITUALITY AND INDUSTRIAL ARCHAEOLOGY

Biella, with its ancient medieval village and its splendid historical buildings, Cittadellarte - Fondazione Pistoletto and its spiritual soul. The Sacro Monte di Oropa, the spiritual soul of these lands, now a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

PROGRAM

DAY 1: Arrival in Biella in the morning and meeting with the guide for a visit to the upper part of the town, which can be reached by funicular railway, with the **medieval hamlet** of Biella Piazza and its characteristic **porticoes** and **noble palaces**. Lunch in a typical restaurant with local dishes. The tour continues with a visit to Biella Centro, with its **neo-Gothic cathedral** and **Romanesque baptistery**. At the end of the tour, a stop at the historic **Caffè del Teatro Sociale** to taste the classic Canestrelli is recommended. Accommodation in a hotel in Sandigliano.

DAY 2: Breakfast based on local produce. After a short drive we reach **Oropa**, the highest Sacro Monte Mariano in Europe and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Return to Biella in the afternoon. A visit to **Cittadellarte - Fondazione Pistoletto** is recommended. Return to the hotel and overnight stay.

DAY 3: After breakfast, depart for Pray to visit one of the most important examples of industrial archaeology in Italy, the Fabbrica della Ruota, formerly the **Zignone Wool Mill**.

SUSTAINABILITY

Biella is a city of great charm, where the recovery of industrial archaeological areas is a model of contemporary and effective sustainability. The experience of the Fabbrica della Ruota and the Cittadellarte, desired by a master of sustainable art such as Michelangelo Pistoletto, are examples of the protection and valorisation of industrial heritage.

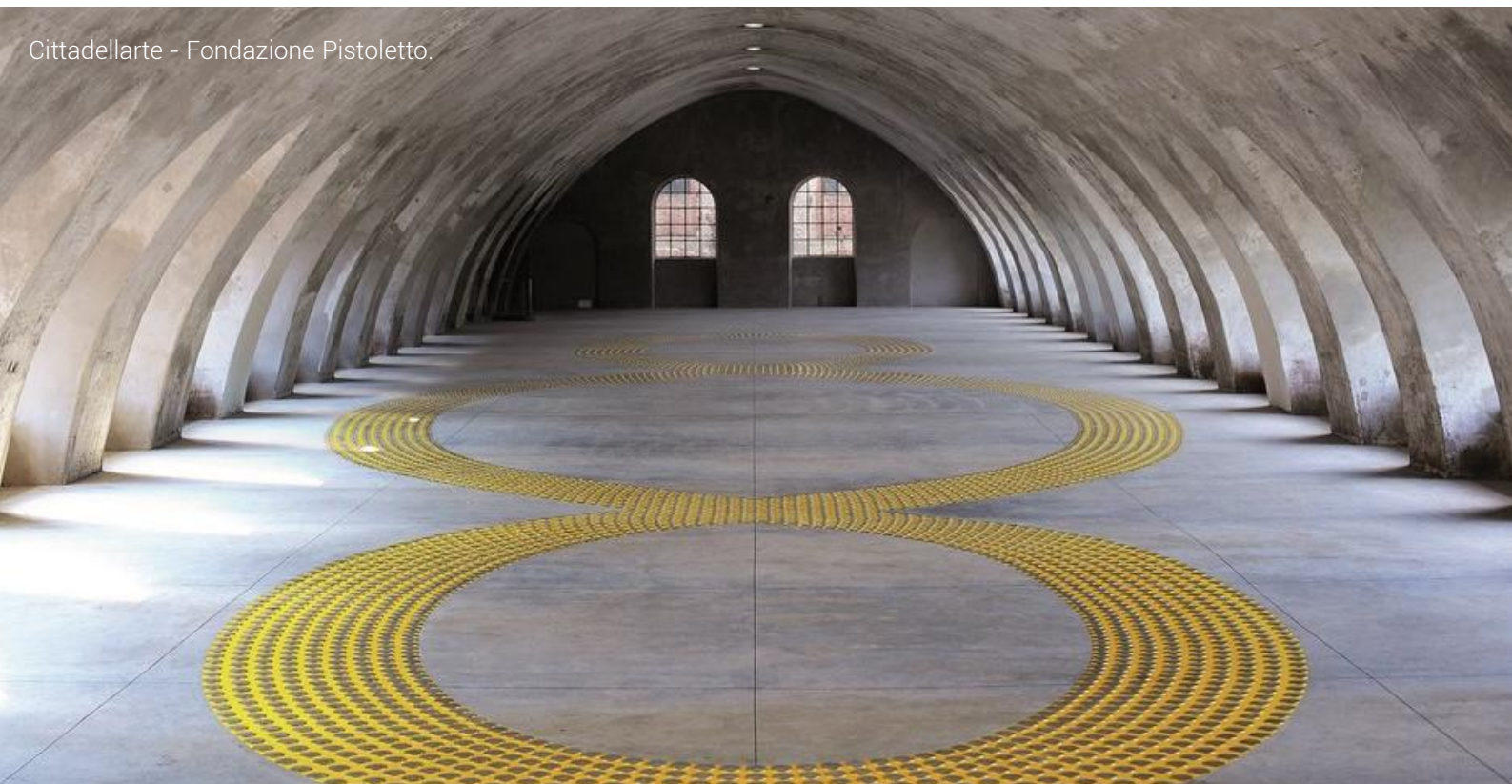

THE VIA FRANCIGENA EPOREDIESE, THE 5 LAKES AND THE CITY OF IVREA

On this three-day trek you will discover the five lakes of Ivrea, with its famous "terre ballerine" (literally dancing lands), the industrial city of Ivrea, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and the Canoe Stadium with the Via Francigena Eporediese, an itinerary for walkers and pilgrims.

PROGRAM

DAY 1: Arrival in Ivrea and presentation of the **itinerary** (with the possibility of using hand bikes or jolettes to enjoy the route). Departure by bus with a reserved platform to discover the "**5 Lakes of Ivrea**", including Lake Sirio, Lake Pistono and the "Terre Ballerine" (Dancing Lands) along the Via Francigena. In the afternoon, we continue along the route to enjoy the **breathtaking views**, with stops for moments of **relaxation and contemplation**. Finally, transfer to Settimo Vittone for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 2: After a typical breakfast, departure by coach to **Ivrea**. A morning visit to the **historic centre** and an afternoon visit to the **industrial town** and the **Canoe Stadium**, a river sports complex that has hosted the World Canoe and Kayak Championships. Dinner in a typical restaurant, return by coach to the hotel and overnight stay.

DAY 3: After breakfast, we recommend an **excursion to the heroic vineyards**, set on man-made terraces on the mountain slopes, a true work of art like the noble Carema wine produced in this area.

SUSTAINABILITY

The sustainability of an area like Ivrea is first and foremost cultural. The idea that Olivetti brought to Italian entrepreneurship was so far ahead of its time that today it would have brought with it a unique environmental awareness. This area enhances it by immersing itself in places such as the 5 Lakes and the Dancing Lands, and by choosing to offset CO2 responsibly.

VAL GERMANASCA, THE VALLEY THAT UNITES

Immerse yourself in the culture and history of this valley. An itinerary of good taste, contact with nature and the rediscovery of ancient stories and traditions.

PROGRAM

DAY 1: Arrival in **Val Germanasca** in the morning. Dinner with typical dishes of the **alpine culture**, prepared with care and imagination with quality products from **local producers**. Overnight stay.

DAY 2: Delicious breakfast with homemade jams and honey, *malga* butter, Alpine cheeses, small fruit and cakes. Meeting with the environmental guide for a **walk through stories, images and tactile aids**, favouring **sensory experiences**. It will also be an opportunity to learn about the **local Waldensian history** and the life of the valley's inhabitants in the past. Free dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 3: After breakfast, departure for **Pinerolo**, the "city of the cavalry", to visit the **Cavalry Historical Museum**. The museum brings to life the last three centuries of Italian history thanks to its rich collection of uniforms, paintings, photographs and sculptures. The museum is considered one of the richest military museums in Europe.

SUSTAINABILITY

The itinerary is an excellent model of integration between the proposal and the territory. From the meals, which highlight the excellence and products of Alpine culture, to the walk, which, by promoting multi-sensoriality, becomes an effective way of making people understand how much sustainability there is naturally in the territories.

ALA-BALME NATURE TRAIL AND ESCURSIONABLE

Balme, a small village at the end of the Val d'Ala, where the watershed with France is formed by majestic peaks. Ala di Stura with its typical stone houses. The path that links the two municipalities allows you to appreciate the natural features, fascinating beech woods and green pastures. The typical products are linked to the activity of the shepherds. The most famous product is the Toma di Lanzo and among the meats the Turgia salami is the most popular. The sweet torcetti di Lanzo and the paste d'melia are not to be missed.

PROGRAM

DAY 1: Arrival and accommodation in a refuge. In the afternoon, hike with a guide along the **Escursionable** route. A visit to the **Eco Museum of the Alpine Guides of Balme** is suggested. Return to the **refuge** and dinner with typical products.

DAY 2: Breakfast with local products and departure for the guided walk from Balme to Ala di Stura along the **Nature Trail**. A tasting of typical products in a restaurant in Ala di Stura is recommended. This is followed by a guided visit to the **sundials** typical of these hamlets. Return to the refuge and overnight stay.

DAY 3: Breakfast with local products. A guided hike from Balme to Pian della Mussa is recommended.

SUSTAINABILITY

The Balme experience is like an immersion in 'real' sustainability because it is able to tell us about it according to different canons of appreciation, and the proposed itinerary hits all of them. From the total immersion in nature to products such as the Turgia salami, made with 'end-of-career' beef, which also adds value to the gastronomic experience.

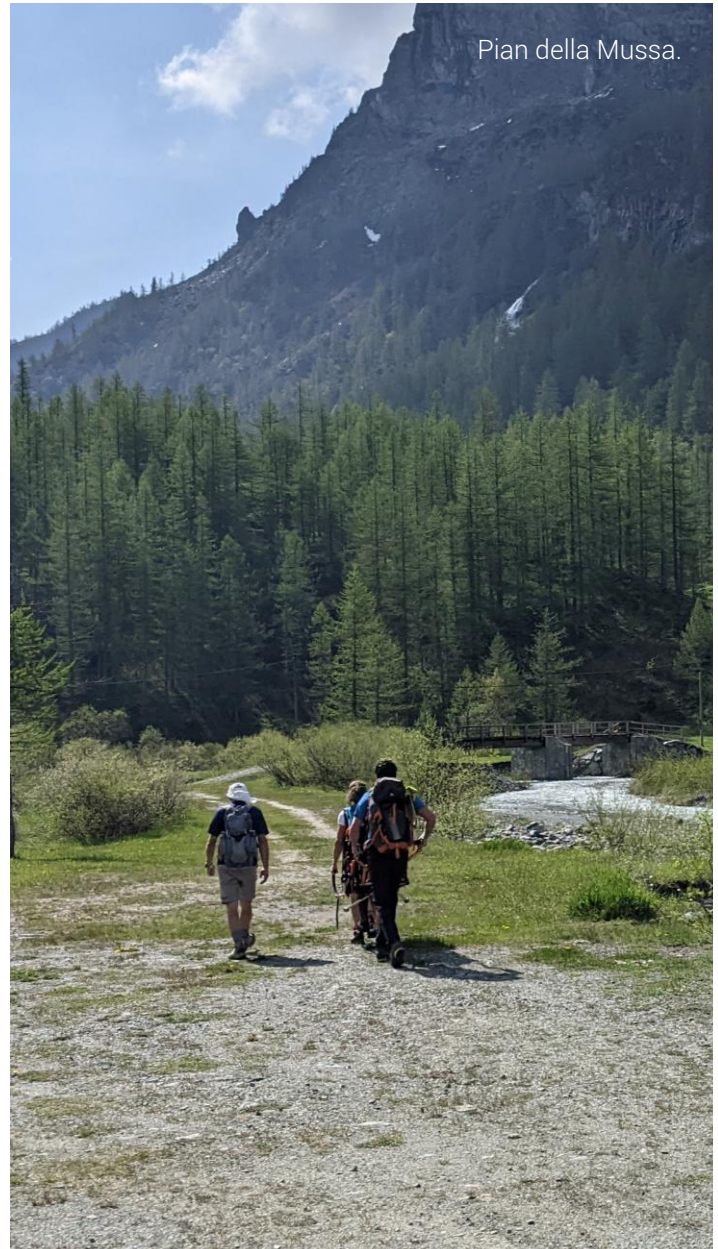

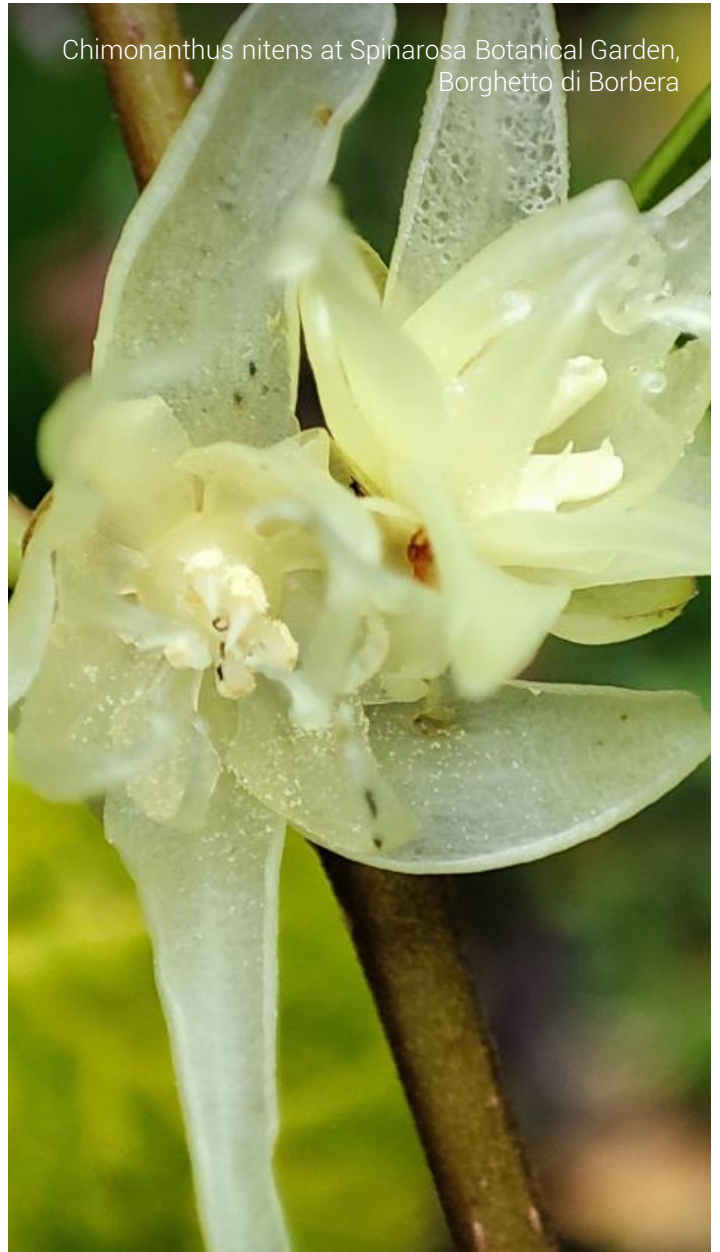

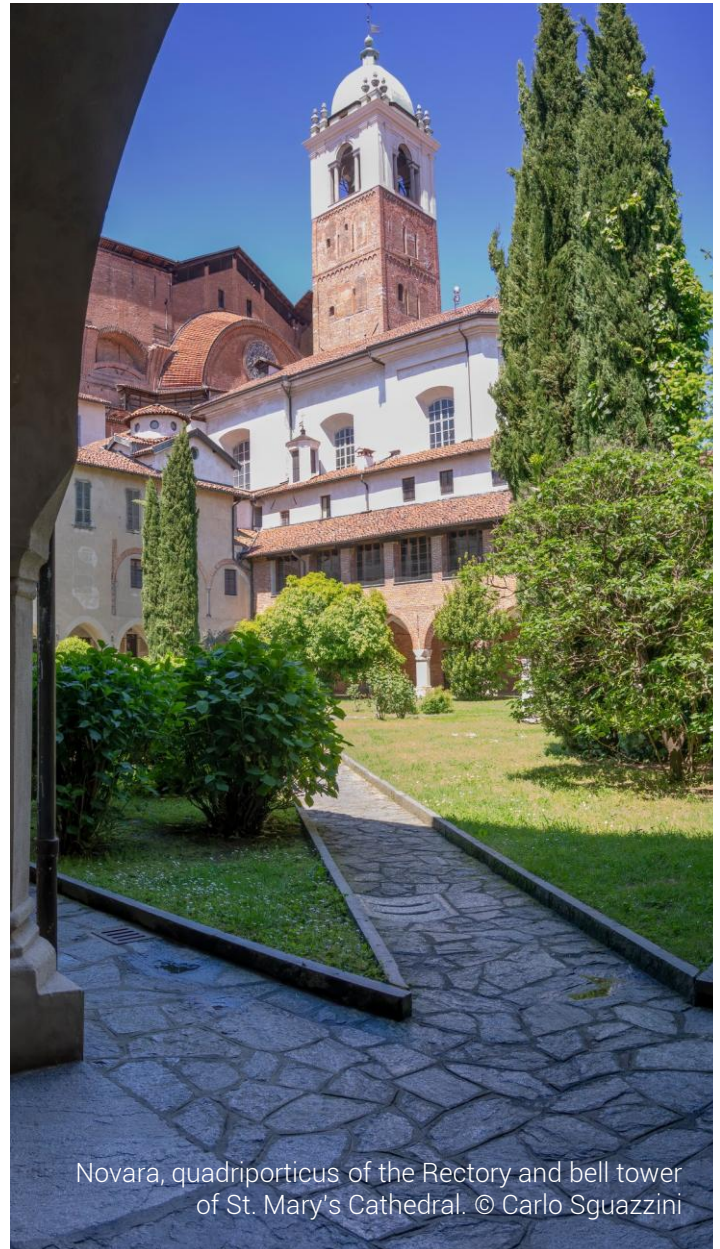

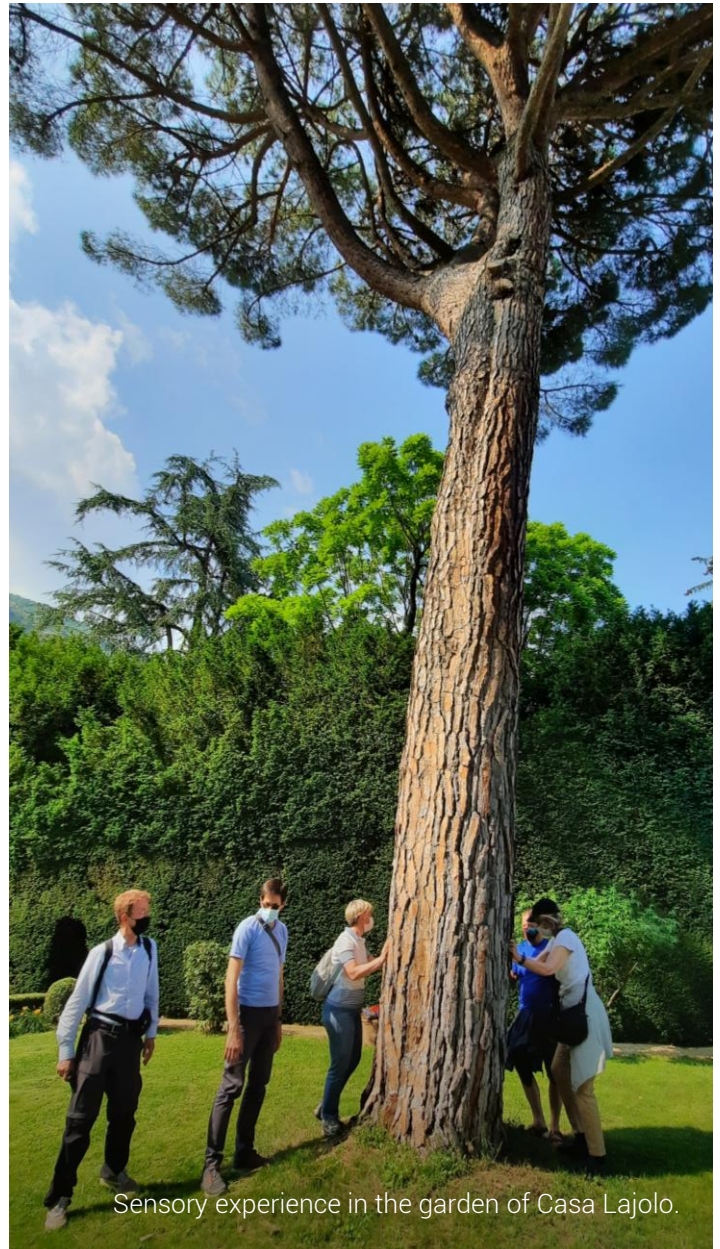
